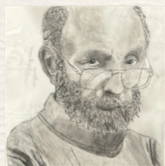

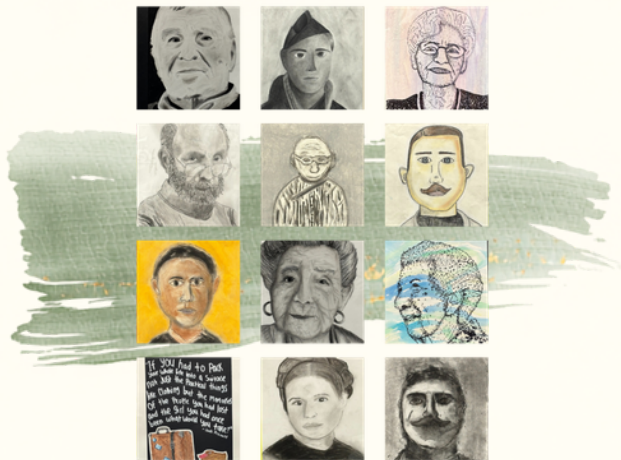

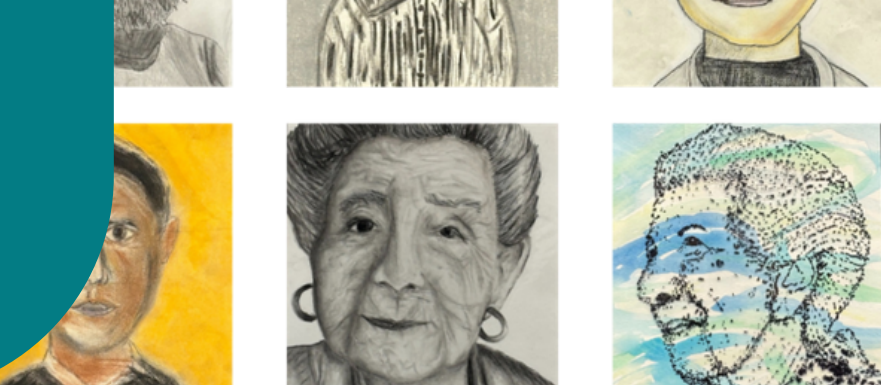

Young Artists Explore Lessons of the Holocaust

➤➤ *About this program*

Art & the Holocaust is an annual program by the Institute for Holocaust Education (IHE) for middle school art teachers and students (grades 6–8) that connects Holocaust history with visual art and reflection.

Participating classrooms receive curriculum materials and a modest stipend for art supplies. Students explore Holocaust history and survivor experiences, then create artwork, typically collages or portraiture of historical figures, accompanied by written reflections. The program concludes with a public exhibition and reception at the Eisenberg Art Gallery at the Jewish Federation of Omaha in April.

Through personal narratives and artistic expression, students deepen their understanding of Holocaust history and reflect on their own learning.
